What are the changes in the system?

- New membership structure
 - To be on the Executive of a Club, a student must be an Arc Member, or have paid the \$40 administration fee
 - To join a constituent club, membership is automatically open to relevant students
- Training for Club Executives
- Improved grant structures

What are the similarities in the system?

- Still have grants and secretarial allowance
- Full-time administration staff
- Clubs Resource space – computers, photocopier, storage, and other resources
- Clubs General Meetings

What benefits are there for Clubs in 2009?

- Clubs affiliated with Arc gain access to funding, support and free or heavily discounted access to advertising, resources and facilities.
- Clubs Resource Centre: computers, photocopier, scanner, data projector, guillotine, laminator, badge-maker, t-shirt screen printer, BBQ hire, table hire, pigeonholes and storage
- Ability to participate in Arc events
- Funding: access to grants and a secretarial allowance
- Insurance: General and Product Liability
- Free room bookings: training rooms, dance studio, music rooms, CATS rooms
- Promotion – cheap or free promotion in Blitz and Tharunka, cheap or free promotion during O-Week and other Arc events
- Training program for Club Executives
