Key Responsibilities

General Volunteers:

- Foster meaningful conversations with students to build their sense of confidence and belonging when starting university

Senior Volunteers:

- Communicate with students during program activations, and answer any questions they may ask about uni
- Foster meaningful conversations with students to build their sense of confidence and belonging when starting university
- Help ideate, execute and run activations
- Responsible for guiding the team each shift, assisting general volunteers, and maintaining team enthusiasm and morale
- Communicate directly with the student program officer about each shift
- Debrief with general volunteers after each shift
