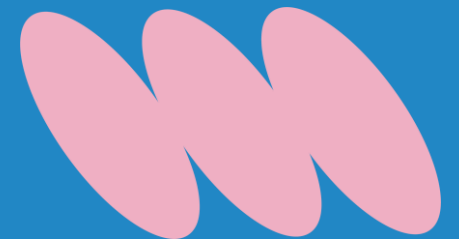




MAHEK HARDASANI
